Directors Report December 2022

Mid-Hudson Training on Demand for trustees and staff: starting in January 2023 all library board members will have to complete two hours in continuing education. Mid-Hudson has created an online training module through Niche Academy that allows trustees to attend trainings online and receive a certificate of attendance. You will receive an invitation in January 2023. There is also a staff training module that includes training for library sustainability, and technology training. We will be able to better manage staff trainings and keep track of progress.

Food for Fines: The program was a great success, we receive a lovely thank you note from God's Store House. They were deeply grateful and wanted to recognize the generosity of our patrons.

Turning outward: I attended a Turning Outward informational session led by Mid-Hudson staff members Rebekkah and Laura Crisci. The training program will start in January. I need to form a team of four people including at least one board member. The team will help with the Community Conversations and accessing the data that we collect. I will attend the next meeting and update you to the next steps.

Fiscal sponsorship update: Gil and I will be meeting with Christine Ritmo about the Farmers Market request for fiscal sponsorship.

Senior Library Clerk: I would like to congratulate Allie Rappleyea, she has been promoted to Senior Library Clerk. Allie is a great asset to our library, she is knowledgeable and kind to everyone who enters the library.

Palenville real estate update: I spoke to Natasha Witka about finding a permanent location for the Palenville Library, she will let me know if any properties in the area become available. I would like to speak in executive session about what our price range is.

Internet upgrade update: General Security has replaced almost all of our hardware and was here on 12/8 and did much of the work. We are still waiting on three network switches that we hope will arrive in January 2023.

Revamping Technology help: Sebastian and Allie are working on a new Technology Help program that will make it easier for staff and patrons to connect. We will also be doing staff tech trainings so more patrons can be helped.
